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Notes:

1. English is the only compulsory subject for Year 11 and for the HSC.
2. Only one subject may be selected from each line (with the exception of Line 6 where you may select a subject from 6A and 6B instead of a 2 unit subject).
3. Students wishing to undertake 3 units of English must select English Advanced from Line 1 and Extension English from Line 6A or B along with another one unit subject from Line 6.
4. Students wishing to undertake 3 units of Mathematics must select Mathematics Advanced from Line 2 and Extension Mathematics from Line 6 along with another one unit subject from Line 4.
5. In Year 11, students are required to study a minimum of 12 units.
6. All subjects offered in Year 11 will be offered in Year 12 the following year.
7. In addition to the subjects offered at the School, Kinross Wolaroi uses external agencies to provide some courses of study for the Higher School Certificate, such as TAFE and Distance Education. These courses comprise a minority of any given student's pattern of study. A minority is defined as no more than four units for the Higher School Certificate. However, it is recommended that at least 10 units of a student's pattern of study is delivered by Kinross Wolaroi School and a maximum of 2 units is delivered from an external agency.
8. Students wishing to study a course at TAFE, or through distance education, should be aware that the cost of each course can range from \$800 to over \$4000 per student per year. Additionally, TAFE charge a work placement fee of from \$170 for each annual 35hr work placement which is a mandatory requirement for most TAFE courses. Funding may be available through the AIS (Association of Independent Schools) to cover a small part of the TAFE charges. Please enter the course name on the front of this page.
9. An additional application form is required for TAFE and Distance Education enrolments. Not all students who apply to enrol in Distance Education courses will be allowed to participate due to Department of Education quotas for independent schools. Priority will be given to students who have demonstrated their ability to work independently and whose original subject choices do not fit the subject lines. TAFE courses are run at the discretion of TAFE.
10. To qualify for an ATAR, students need to have completed 10 units of study in Year 12 with no more than 2 of those units coming from a TAFE or Category B course (at Kinross Wolaroi we offer three Category B courses – Hospitality, English Studies and Primary Industries. Should students wish to take a TAFE course and a Category B course and still qualify for an ATAR, their Year 12 pattern of study must include at least 8 units of Category A subjects. With the exception of Hospitality, English Studies and Primary Industries, all HSC courses offered at Kinross Wolaroi School are Category A courses.
