# **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

## ABOUT INDIVIDUAL TUITION FOR PERFORMING ARTS

Kinross Wolaroi School is fortunate to have a highly-experienced staff of salaried and visiting teachers who offer individual lessons on a wide range of instruments as well as Singing, Speech and Drama and Musicianship.

#### **CONDITIONS OF TUITION**

It is our hope that students enrolling in private music lessons would commit to a full year of tuition. However, should a student wish to discontinue or defer lessons, notification must be made by the parent/guardian in writing to the tutor 30 days in advance of your intention to cease lessons. The 30 day period can cover both term time and holidays. Fees will remain payable until the end of the notice period and the final lesson as agreed upon with the tutor. Deferment of lessons due to illness or misadventure must be sought by a parent/guardian in writing to the tutor.

## **RE-SCHEDULING LESSONS**

If you need to cancel a lesson, 24 hours notice must be given. If inadequate notice is given, you will be charged for the lesson. It is at the teacher's discretion to make up missed lessons (including lessons missed due to forgotten equipment/instruments).

#### **ASSESSMENT**

Students are given reports on their progress at the end of each semester. Student assessment is made in consultation with the Instrumental Music Teacher and the Co-ordinator of Instrumental Music. External examinations may be taken with the Australian Music Examinations Board (AMEB) which are facilitated within the school. Please see individual teachers for further details.

# PRACTICE COMMITMENT

Private music tuition is a serious commitment and requires an undertaking on the part of the student to carry out all practice tasks set by the teacher and to attend lessons and associated activities. Students need to follow direction in the Music Lesson Diary in order to make the best progress on their instrument. Music Lesson Diaries are available for purchase from the Music Centre for \$5 each which is charged to your school account.

# **INDIVIDUAL TUITION FEES**

Each term you will be invoiced directly by the Instrumental Music Teacher which means that tuition will NOT be billed to your school account. The only exception is for lessons given by our permanent music staff, Mrs. L Moxey and Ms. D Innes, who will charge tuition to your school account. Performing arts tuition will be charged at the rates below.

# **MUSICIANSHIP CLASSES**

Students sitting practical AMEB examinations for Third Grade and above are strongly encouraged to pursue the study of

Musicianship. Musicianship is a requirement for the awarding of AMEB instrumental certificates at Sixth Grade level and above. In 2020 Kinross Wolaroi School will offer musicianship classes for Grades 1-5 conditional upon sufficient enrolments within each grade. Classes are held as a group lesson before school from 8am to 8.45am once a week. Musicianship exams are held in second Semester each year and are taken online.

# **MUSICIANSHIP FEE STRUCTURE**

The fee for musicianship classes is \$160 per semester for all grades. This fee will be charged to your school account at the beginning of each semester. This fee does not include a practice workbook or online exam enrolment.

#### **ENSEMBLES**

Students learning an instrument/vocals at Kinross Wolaroi School are expected to participate in at least one school ensemble or choir upon reaching the required standard.

#### **INSTRUMENT HIRE**

It is recommended that each student owns their own instrument. However, a number of school instruments are available for hire, including: Clarinet, Oboe, Bassoon, Saxophone, Flute, Piccolo, Euphonium, Baritone, Trombone, Trumpet, Cornet, French Horn, Tuba, Violin, Viola, Cello and Double Bass (all subject to availability).

Instrument accessories (and the replacement of them) i.e. reeds, strings etc. are the responsibility of the student.

# **INSTRUMENT HIRE CHARGES**

Upon hire, a \$160 bond will be charged to your school account (refunded upon return of instrument in good condition). The on-going fee for instrumental hire is \$160 per semester for all instruments. This fee will be charged to your school account at the beginning of each semester.

Parents will be liable for costs for: (a) any damage to instruments caused by a deliberate act or default on the part of the student and (b) replacement of a lost (through lack of care/negligence) or unreturned instrument.

## **INSTRUMENTAL LOCKERS**

There are instrumental lockers in the Music Centre which are available to students. It is highly recommended that students obtain a locker to ensure their instrument is kept safe and secure. A \$20 bond will be charged to your school account which is refundable on return of the locker key. Please see the Performing Arts Administrator to obtain a locker hire form.
