1. These lines have been formed using the initial choices made by the students of this cohort.
2. English is the only compulsory subject for Year 11 and for the HSC.
3. Only a very small number of students elected not to do a Mathematics course, so a Mathematics line exists for this cohort.
4. Only one subject may be selected from each line (with the exception of Line 6 where you may select a subject from 6A and 6B instead of a 2 unit subject).
5. Students wishing to undertake 3 units of English must select English Advanced from Line 1 and Extension English from Line 6 along with another one unit subject from Line 6.
6. Students wishing to undertake 3 units of Mathematics must select Mathematics Advanced from Line 2 and Extension Mathematics from Line 6 along with another one unit subject from Line 6.
7. In Year 11, students are required to study a minimum of 12 units.
8. If the number of students choosing a subject is very small, the School reserves the right not to offer that subject. Some subjects did not get offered in the final subject lines due to insufficient interest shown in the initial subject selection process. All subjects offered in Year 11 will be offered in Year 12 the following year.
9. In addition to the subjects offered at the School, Kinross Wolaroi uses external agencies to provide some courses of study for the Higher School Certificate, such as TAFE and Distance Education. These courses comprise a minority of any given student's pattern of study. A minority is defined as no more than four units for the Higher School Certificate. However, it is recommended that at least 10 units of a student's pattern of study is delivered by Kinross Wolaroi School and a maximum of 2 units is delivered from an external agency.
10. Students wishing to study a course at TAFE, or through distance education, should be aware that the cost of each course can range from \$800 to over \$3000 per student per year. Funding may be available through the AIS (Association of Independent Schools) to cover a small part of the TAFE charges. Please enter the course name on the front of this page.
11. An additional application form is required for TAFE and Distance Education enrolments. Not all students who apply to enrol in Distance Education courses will be allowed to participate due to Department of Education quotas for independent schools. Priority will be given to students who have demonstrated their ability to work independently and whose original subject choices do not fit the subject lines.
